CERTIFICATE OF ANALYSIS CHOLERA TOXIN B SUBUNIT (LOW SALT) Lot #10431B1

<u>Contents</u>

Each vial of cholera toxin B subunit (choleragenoid), when reconstituted to 0.25 ml with water, contains 0.5 mg of protein in 0.01 M sodium phosphate, pH 7.5. Handle product gently; do not vortex.

Concentration

Protein concentration was determined by absorbance at 280 nm using an extinction coefficient of 0.96 for 1 mg/ml solution.¹

Purity

When examined on 4-12% SDS-polyacrylamide gels, this protein migrates as a single band with an apparent molecular weight of 11,000 Da. Densitometric analysis estimates the purity of the product as >95%. The ratio of absorbance at 280 and 260 nm ($R_{280/260}$) is 2.0. This product has been tested for endotoxin levels and was found to be acceptable.

<u>Assay</u>

Ganglioside binding activity was assessed by a hemagglutination assay. The activity of this lot was comparable to the standard.

Packaging/Storage

This product is provided as a lyophilized powder, sealed under vacuum. Store at 2-8°C. **DO NOT FREEZE**.

<u>Handling</u>

Good laboratory technique should be employed in the proper handling of this product. Wear appropriate laboratory attire including a lab coat, gloves and safety glasses. Nitrile gloves are recommended when handling lyophilized material.
